AC1200 Mesh Wi-Fi Range Extender



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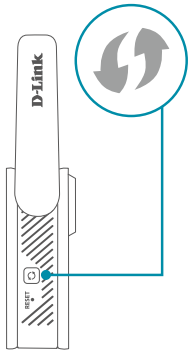
INSTALLATION

OPTION 1

QUICK WPS SETUP

You easily can pair your device with any router to extend your wireless network.

- 1 / Plug the DAP-1610 into a power source near your wireless router.
Wait until the LED starts blinking orange.
- 2 / Press the WPS button on your router for 3 seconds. Refer to your router's manual for router behaviour.
- 3 / Press the WPS button on your DAP-1610 for 2-3 seconds. The status LED should start to blink green.
- 4 / When the Status LED turns solid green (may take up to 5 minutes), this indicates that your DAP-1610 is securely connected to your wireless router.



Your setup is complete! You can now unplug and move your device to a location between your router and the area where you want wireless coverage. By default, your device will share the same Wi-Fi name and password as your router.

IMPORTANT

WPS may be disabled on some Routers or Modems. If the WPS Status LED on your Router or Modem does not start blinking when you have pressed the WPS button, try again and hold it a little longer. If it still does not blink, STOP, and configure your DAP-1610 using **Option 2: D-Link Wi-Fi App Setup.**

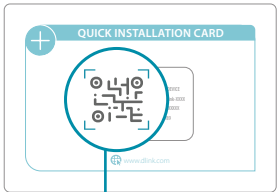
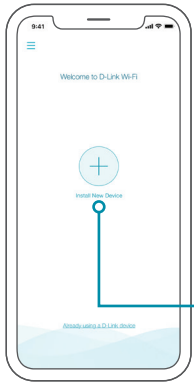
OPTION 2

D-LINK WI-FI APP SETUP

- 1 / Download the D-Link Wi-Fi app and launch it.



- 2 / Tap **Install New Device**. Scan the QR code on the Quick Installation Card. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the setup.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why can't I connect to my wireless router or my wireless connection drops?

Verify that your extender is within range of your wireless router. Try plugging it into a location closer to the router and verify that the Status LED is solid green. Note that when extending a wireless signal from a router or access point, devices connected to the extender will not get the same speed/throughput as when connected directly to the router.

How do I access the web-based configuration utility?

To access the web-based configuration utility, connect to the device's network using an Ethernet cable or by using its Wi-Fi Name/SSID and password, then type the device specific URL into a browser. The device specific URL is written in the format of **http://dlinkap<WXYZ>.local./** where **<WXYZ>** changes per the device and is located on the device's label.

Why can't I access the Internet?

Verify that your extender is working by rebooting the extender. If you still can not connect to the Internet, contact your Internet service provider.

What do I do if I forgot my device password / my wireless network password?

If you forgot your password, you must reset your extender. This process will change all your settings back to the factory defaults.

How do I restore the extender to its factory default settings?

Locate the reset button. With the extender powered on, use a paper clip to hold the button down for a second. Release the button and the extender will go through its reboot process.

How do I select a Wi-Fi band to extend?

In order to select a specific Wi-Fi band to extend, you must set up the device via the D-Link Wi-Fi app or through the web-based configuration utility.



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
